Grace-empowered Forgiveness

Colossians 4:7-8 NKJ

⁷Tychicus, a beloved brother, faithful minister, and fellow servant in the Lord, will <u>tell you</u> all the news about me.

⁸I am sending him to you for this very purpose, that he may know your circumstances and comfort your hearts,

Colossians 4:9a NKJ

with Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, who is one of you. . .

Philemon 1:8b-21 NLT

- ⁸... I am boldly asking a favor of you. I could demand it in the name of Christ because it is the right thing for you to do.
- ⁹ But because of our love, I prefer simply to ask you. Consider this as a request from me—Paul, an old man and now also a prisoner for the sake of Christ Jesus.
- ¹⁰I appeal to you to show kindness to my child, Onesimus. I became his father in the faith while here in prison.
- ¹¹ Onesimus hasn't been of much use to you in the past, but now he is very useful to both of us. ¹² I am sending him back to you, and with him comes my own heart.
- ¹³ I wanted to keep him here with me while I am in these chains for preaching the Good News, and he would have helped me on your behalf.
- ¹⁴ But I didn't want to do anything without your consent. I wanted you to help because you were willing, not because you were forced.
- ¹⁵ It seems you lost Onesimus for a little while so that you could have him back forever.
- ¹⁶He is no longer like a slave to you. He is more than a slave, for he is a beloved brother, especially to me. Now he will mean much more to you, both as a man and as a brother in the Lord.
- ¹⁷ So if you consider me your partner, welcome him as you would welcome me.
- ¹⁸ If he has wronged you in any way or owes you anything, charge it to me.
- ¹⁹I, PAUL, WRITE THIS WITH MY OWN HAND: I WILL REPAY IT. AND I WON'T MENTION THAT YOU OWE ME YOUR VERY SOUL!
- ²⁰ Yes, my brother, please do me this favor for the Lord's sake. Give me this encouragement in Christ.
- ²¹ I am confident as I write this letter that you will do what I ask and even more!

⁹I am also sending Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, one of your own people. He and Tychicus will tell you everything that's happening here.

¹⁰ Aristarchus, who is in prison with me, sends you his greetings, and so does Mark, <u>Barnabas's cousin</u>. As you were instructed before, make Mark welcome if he comes your way.

¹¹ Jesus (the one we call Justus) also sends his greetings. These are the only Jewish believers among my co-workers; they are working with me here for the Kingdom of God. And what a comfort they have been!

2. Forgiveness ______ while Allowing God to Change Others

Acts 13:5 NLT

There, in the town of Salamis, they went to the Jewish synagogues and preached the word of God. (John Mark went with them as their assistant.)

Acts 13:13 NLT

Now Paul and those with him left Paphos by ship for Pamphylia,* landing at the port town of Perga. There John Mark <u>left them</u> and returned to Jerusalem.

Acts 15:36-40 NLT

- ³⁶ After some time Paul said to Barnabas, "Let's return to each city where we previously preached the word of the Lord, to see how the new believers are getting along."
- ³⁷ Barnabas agreed and wanted to take along John Mark.
- ³⁸ But Paul disagreed strongly, since John Mark had deserted [withdrew, shun, flee from] them in Pamphylia and had not continued with them in their work.
- ³⁹ Their disagreement [contention, dispute] was so sharp that they separated [divided]. Barnabas took John Mark with him and sailed for Cyprus.
- ⁴⁰ Paul chose Silas, and as he left, the believers entrusted him to the Lord's gracious care.

Colossians 4:10 NKJ

Aristarchus my fellow prisoner greets you, with Mark the cousin of Barnabas (about whom you received instructions: if he comes to you, welcome him),

2 Timothy 4:11 NKJ

Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful to me for ministry.

Colossians 4:12 NKJ

¹²Epaphras, who is one of you, a bondservant of Christ, greets you, always laboring fervently for you in prayers, that you may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

Colossians 4:13 NKJ

For I bear him witness that he has a great zeal for you, and those who are in Laodicea, and those in Hierapolis.
